Gray's mother told officers she was celebrating her birthday with her boyfriend when he began disrespecting her. As the argument escalated, Gray retrieved a firearm and began fighting with her boyfriend, eventually shooting him. The victim was struck in the inner left thigh and was taken to the hospital. Gray was arrested and charged with Aggravated Assault and Recklessly Endangering Another Person. (53210)

3/25/17 Robbery - 5905 Station Street (Advanced Auto). Employees reported that they were preparing to close the store for the evening when a **black male, 5'11", 205 pounds, wearing a black mask, black hoodie and black pants** entered the store. The male approached the store manager and demanded all of the money while brandishing a black handgun. The store manager opened two of the registers and instructed her employee to open the other register. The actor then knocked the manger to the ground and fled from the store with an unknown amount of cash. The Mobile Crime Unit and Robbery detectives responded to the scene. (53817)

Notable Arrests

3/22/17 at 3:55 PM - Elora Way & Rosetta Street (Garfield): Pittsburgh Police Narcotics detectives were on patrol in the Garfield Section of Pittsburgh when they observed a known male with no valid license operating a vehicle in the 5500 block of Hillcrest Street. The detectives activated their lights and sirens and attempted to initiate a traffic stop. The driver of the vehicle refused to pull over. After several blocks, Thomas drove into the side yard of a house in the 5300 block of Kinkaid Street, exited the car, and fled on foot. The detectives pursued Thomas on foot and observed a black firearm fall out of his pocket before catching up to him and placing him in custody. A Beretta 9mm pistol was recovered, along with a pill bottle containing oxycodone pills. **Deandre Thomas, 25, of Braddock**, was arrested and charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance, Firearms not to be Carried without a License, Person Not To Possess Use Manufacture or Sell a Firearm and various violations of the Vehicle Code. 3/23/17 at 10:00 AM - 625 Brushton Avenue (New Brotherhood Biker Club - Homewood): Pittsburgh Police VCU and Narcotics detectives served a search warrant at the New Brotherhood Biker Club. During the search, officers found two individuals in the building and observed a Mossberg 12-gauge shotgun near and a gallon sized bag of marijuana. As they continued searching the structure they observed another rifle and shotgun leaning against a wall in another room. Detectives ended up seizing multiple shotguns, rifles, pistols, ammunition, marijuana, digital scales and additional paraphernalia. **Albert Green 61, of Homewood,** was arrested and charged with Possession with Intent to Deliver a Controlled Substance, Possession of a Controlled Substance and Paraphernalia.
