Homewood / East Hills

12/19/16 Aggravated Assault (Shooting) - 2105 Park Hill Drive, 1:16 PM. A 35 year-old male reported that he heard a knock at the door and when he opened it, three people forced their way inside. The victim identified the female suspect as "Tynisha Nicole Fouser" and one of the males as her brother, known only as "Man-Man." The third suspect was unknown. "Man-Man" fired a shot at the victim, striking him in the shoulder. All three suspects then fled the area. The victim was taken to UPMC Presbyterian in stable condition. *If you have any information on the identity of "Man-Man," or any further information on Fouser, you can reply to this e-mail or call Zone 5 station at 412-665-3605. 12/19/16 Homicide (Shooting) - 2200 block Wilner Drive, 9:10 PM. A 25 year-old female victim was found shot to death behind the wheel of a silver Pontiac G6 which was parked in the 2200 block of Wilner Drive. A male shooter was observed fleeing the area on foot immediately after the shooting. VCU detectives are working this case. (236025)

12/20/16 Burglary – 500 block Oakwood Street. Victim arrived home to find the rear door open and several items missing from his home. There was forced entry to the rear door. (236346)

12/20/16 Burglary – 7310 Race Street. Victim came home from work and noticed several items out of place and presents missing from under her Christmas tree. Victim later learned from her daughter that the side door was open when she came downstairs early this morning to get ready for school. (236473)

12/21/16 Stolen Vehicle – Tioga Street & N. Dunfermline Street, 7:28 AM. Officers responded to a silver Cadillac crashed into a telephone pole. While responding to the crash, officers received an update that the same vehicle had just been reported stolen from a residence in the 7200 block of Tioga Street. The driver had left the car running while she ran inside her house. When she came back out, the vehicle was gone. When officers arrived at the scene of the crash, they found that the Cadillac had been abandoned. The vehicle was recovered by the owner. (236829)

12/21/16 Stolen Vehicle – 800 block Brushton Avenue. Victim reported that her 2003 green GMC Denali had been stolen one week earlier after she left it running when she ran into Bett's Market on Brushton Avenue to purchase "blunts". It is unknown why the victim waited a week to report the theft, but she did state that a friend saw the car recently at the Wendy's drive-

thru on Penn Avenue in Wilksburg. On 12/24/16, **Sean Donnell Daniels, 24, of East Liberty**, was arrested after officers stopped the vehicle. (237223)

12/22/16 Burglary – Wheeler Street. Victim returned home to find his kitchen window broken. Nothing appeared to be missing. (237861)

12/24/16 Burglary – 2200 block Wilner Drive. Victim is in the process of moving into her house. She was last at the residence on 12/17/16 and arrived again on 12/23/16 to find the front window lock tampered with and the house in disarray. Electronics and baby clothes were stolen. (238744)

12/25/16 Robbery – Felicia Way, 5:00 PM. A 29 year-old female victim told officers that she was walking down Felicia Way when a man approached and asked her for a few dollars. When she took \$5.00 out of her pocket, the male snatched it out of her hand and ran away. **The suspect is a black male, 5'8", dark complexion, with a salt & pepper beard.** (236288)

12/25/16 Burglary – 2200 block Wilner Drive. Victim was asleep when she heard glass breaking. The victim remained in her bedroom for safety until she no longer heard any noises. She then went downstairs to find her door frame cracked. Christmas presents were missing. (239016)

12/26/16 Aggravated Assault (Shooting) – 7246 Kelly Street (Galaxy Bar), 12:56 AM. Officers responded to a male shot at the Galaxy Bar. Upon their arrival, they met with security staff who indicated that they disarmed the shooter but he left the scene. According to bar security, the male was firing shots at another individual and the security officers fired a Taser at the shooter. The shooter dropped his gun and fled. Security recovered a .22 caliber pistol and handed it over to officers. Officers located the shooter nearby and took him into custody after a struggle. He was identified as **Anthony Lamar Williams, 27, of Wilksburg**. The victim of the shooting is a 23 year-old male who was taken to the hospital with gunshot wounds to the chest and thigh. He was in stable condition. (239377)

Larimer / Lincoln-Lemington

12/18/16 Burglary – 5500 block Meadow Street. Victim told officers that her apartment was burglarized between 12/16 and 12/18. Christmas presents for her four children were stolen. (235217)

12/19/16 Aggravated Assault (Shooting) - 1300 block Paulson Avenue, 1:18 PM. An 18 year-old male victim reported that he was walking along Paulson Avenue towards Paulson Park when he observed a **burgundy Lexus with tinted windows** pass him very slowly. The Lexus came back down the street and someone inside the vehicle fired (3) shots at the victim, striking him in the

left hip. The victim was taken to UPMC Presbyterian in stable condition. No suspects at this time. (235786)

12/20/16 Aggravated Assault (Shooting) - 1300 block Paulson Avenue, 9:16PM. Officers were patrolling Paulson Avenue when they were flagged-down by a male who stated that his friend had just been shot up the street. Officers found a 21 year-old male victim at the corner of Paulson Avenue & Lemington Avenue, suffering from a gunshot wound to the abdomen. The victim was taken to the hospital in stable condition. The victim's friend told officers that the two of them were walking to the corner store when they were approached by two unknown suspects who demanded all of their belongings. **Suspect # 1 is a black male, 5'8" 150 Lbs, wearing black pants and a black hooded sweatshirt. Suspect # 2 is a black male, 5'9" 190 Lbs, also wearing a black pants and a black hooded sweatshirt.** No further description available.

12/20/16 Theft from Vehicle – Paulson Avenue & Brainard Street. (236676)

12/21/16 Burglary – 7100 block Ross Garden Road. Victim returned home to find his back bedroom window open. A Remington shotgun, expensive coins, and a CD player were missing. (237645)

12/23/16 Burglary – 6500 block Shetland Street. Victims of both the 1st and 2nd floor apartments arrived home to find electronics missing. (238391 / 238401)

12/24/16 Home Invasion – 1100 block Paulson Avenue, 1:10 PM. A 23 year-old male victim told officers that he heard a knock on his front door. When he answered it, two suspects were standing outside. One of the suspects was at the base of his steps acting as a lookout while the other suspect put a gun to his head and stated “I know what you did. I should kill you.” The victim told officers he had no idea what the man was talking about and fled from the suspect. Both suspects got into a **gray 4-door vehicle (possibly a Pontiac)** and drove off. **The man with the gun was described as a black male, 50-60 year old, heavy build, 5'7". The other male was black, 20-30 years old, 5'6", skinny.** The victim stated that he thought he recognized the man with the gun as someone who recently did work on his home. Detectives are investigating. (238749)

12/25/16 Carjacking – Lincoln Avenue & Apple Avenue, 9:13 PM. A 36 year-old male victim told responding officers that he was meeting a drug-dealer named “Shawn” to buy marijuana. When he arrived at the intersection, a black male dressed in blue jeans and a black hooded sweatshirt pointed a gun at him and demanded his money. The suspect took \$175.00 cash and fled in the victim’s vehicle. The vehicle is a **black Nissan Frontier rental vehicle.** No plate information is available at this time. (239316)

Bloomfield/Garfield/Friendship

12/18/16 Burglary – 5200 block Hillcrest Street. Victim returned home to find the windows broken and the front door open. Nothing was missing. This home was under renovation at the time of the burglary. (235167)

12/18/16 Burglary – 5400 block Kincaid Street. Victim was out of town and her brother was house-sitting. On 12/16 he contacted her to report that her rear window was broken and a 47" Hitachi TV had been stolen. 12/22/16 Stolen Vehicle – 100 block Roup Avenue. Victim awoke to find his vehicle gone. It is a **2012 white Chevrolet Volt (California plate 6VWL313)**. (237470)

12/21/16 Burglary – Gilford Court. Security at East Liberty Gardens housing complex reported that two vacant units had been burglarized. Copper pipes were stolen. (237294)

Four employees of the business reported that two men came into the car wash with guns as they were preparing to close for the evening. Suspect # 1 is a black male, 18-30 years old, 6'2", medium build, wearing a grey hooded sweatshirt, black pants, and a ski mask. Suspect # 2 is a black male, 18-30, thin build, wearing a black hooded sweatshirt, black pants, a ski mask, and carrying an orange backpack. The suspects demanded money and made off with an undisclosed amount of cash. The suspects fled. There were no injuries. (237765)



Notable Arrests

12/20/16 at 3:48 AM – 2300 block Park Hill Drive (East Hills): Officers Maddox and Flicker were on patrol in the East Hills when they came upon a man who appeared to be sleeping in the driver's seat of a vehicle that was running in the parking lot (a black Chevrolet Impala). When officers approached they saw marijuana in plain view near the gear shift. Further, they checked the vehicle information and found that the car was reported stolen out of Wilkinsburg. Officers woke the male, **Michael Anthony Johnson-Barber, 29, of Monroeville**, and took him into custody. Officers recovered (2) "bricks" of heroin (100 stamp bags) with no markings and (2) additional "bundles" of heroin (20 stamp bags) marked "Ride It." Officers also learned that he had a warrant out for his arrest. Johnson-Barber was transported to the ACJ. (236151)

12/20/16 at 1:40 PM – Allegheny County Jail: Members of the US Marshall's Western PA Fugitive Task force arrested **Tyler Johnson, 17, of East Liberty**, on charges of Criminal Conspiracy and Robbery, stemming from an armed robbery on 8/11/16 at the basketball courts in the 100 block of N. St. Clair Street. Johnson's co-defendant, **Sean Redmon, 18, of Garfield** has already been taken into custody. *Due to the seriousness of the crime, Johnson has been charged as an adult.* (150139)

12/20/16 at 9:30 PM – Penn Avenue & S. Pacific Avenue (Friendship): Narcotics & Vice detectives were working undercover in the area when they observed **Meissa Fignar, 36, of West Penn Place (Friendship)**, flagging-down passing cars. A detective pulled alongside her and Fignar got into his vehicle. She agreed to perform a sex act in exchange for \$30.00. The detective noticed Fignar holding a crack pipe and inquired about smoking crack cocaine with her, at which point Fignar showed him a rock of crack that she had in her hand. At this point, the arrest team moved-in and took Fignar into custody. (236650)

12/20/16 at 11:15 PM – N. Graham Street & Kincaid Street (Garfield): Pittsburgh Police Narcotics & Vice detectives observed suspected drug activity at a residence in the 300 block of N. Graham Street. The detectives stopped and spoke with **Jordan Cosgrove, 26, (Unknown address)**, after he was observed leaving the house in question. Cosgrove was found to have three warrants out for his arrest. He was also found to be in possession of crack cocaine and a crack pipe. Cosgrove was arrested without incident. (236702)

12/21/16 at 1:39 AM – Frankstown Avenue & Paulson Avenue (Larimer): Officer Matson was patrolling Larimer when he pulled behind a stolen silver Kia Sportage. He radioed for back-up and followed the vehicle until enough units were nearby. Officers conducted a traffic stop and took the driver into custody. He was identified as **Darnell Edward Trowell, 24, of Wilksburg.** (236741)

12/21/16 at 7:35 PM – 300 block N. Graham Street (Garfield): Pittsburgh Police Narcotics & Vice detectives and PGH SWAT served a search warrant on a home in this block following an undercover drug investigation. During the search, the following items were recovered: crack cocaine, a digital scale, drug packaging materials, \$1,200.00 cash. Additionally, partially-destroyed crack cocaine was found in the kitchen sink disposal when the team entered the residence, leading officers to believe that the occupants of the home were attempting to destroy evidence. Arrested were **Anthony Coker, 39, of Garfield, and Parrish Rush, 47, of Garfield.** Both were charged with Criminal Conspiracy and felony drug offenses. (237301)

12/24/16 at 3:29 AM – Lemington Avenue & Toga Way (Lincoln-Lemington): Officers Macioce and Haule were patrolling Lincoln-Lemington when they came upon a man sleeping in a running vehicle on Lemington Avenue. Officers went to check on the driver and saw a bag of crack cocaine in the car when they shined their flashlights on the driver. Officers woke the driver and asked him to step from the vehicle. The male originally gave the name Jamal Lewis but later admitted that was not his real name. He then gave the name Jamal Graham, but officers found this was a bad name as well. The male was arrested as **John Doe, approximately 30 years old, unknown address.** The vehicle was searched and officers found crack cocaine, marijuana, a digital scale, and several cell phones. 12/24/16 at 12:30 PM – 300 block N. Aiken Avenue (Garfield): Officers DeSaro and Davis responded to a call for a suspicious male in the area. Upon arriving in the area they found a male who fit the description of the person in the 911 call. They stopped to talk to **Mister Davis,**

20, of Garfield. Davis was found to be in possession of a loaded Smith & Wesson .45 cal pistol. He was disarmed without incident. Mr. Mister Davis was transported to the ACJ. (238724)
