**Homewood / East Hills**

**8/17/15 Robbery (Domestic) – 1000 block Brushton Avenue, 6:35pm.** A 22 year-old female victim reports that her boyfriend, **Derrick DeAndre Eggleton, 22, of Garfield**, assaulted her, then grabbed her phone from her. He then stole her keys, wallet, and X-Box game system, and fled the scene. Officers will obtain an arrest warrant for Eggleton. *He will be charged with Robbery and Simple Assault (154583)*

**8/18/15 Burglary – 700 block N. Dallas Avenue, Occurred between 8/14 and 8/17.** Victim reports someone forced open her front door and stole (2) speakers. The victim suspects her landlord of the burglary and has had problems with him in the past. (155439)

**8/19/15 Burglary – 2000 block Fairlawn Street, Occurred between 5:00pm and 6:00pm.** Victim reports someone smashed his bathroom window, entered his house, and stole (30) pair of tennis shoes, jewelry, and a Sony PlayStation. (156118)

**8/19/15 Homicide (Shooting) – 1800 block Fahnestock Street, 5:15pm.** A 22 year old male and (3) of his friends came to Pittsburgh from Sharon (PA), in order to purchase a TV and a game system from a known acquaintance. Upon arriving at the home on Fahnestock Street, they learned there was no TV for sale and instead they were robbed. During the robbery, the victim was shot multiple times in front of the home on Fahnestock Street. The responding officers immediately surrounded the home and began calling over the PA system for the occupants to exit. (4) occupants exited the house and were taken to Pittsburgh Police headquarters for questioning. The victim was taken to UPMC Presbyterian where he died from his wounds. Pittsburgh Police Homicide Squad is handling this case and currently has an arrest warrant for **Deshawn Hall, 23, of East Hills**. **8/20/15 Shots Fired (Car Struck) – 7000 block Apple Avenue, 8:00pm.** Officers responded to a ShotSpotter alert at the above location and arrived to find a blue Nissan Altima with multiple bullet holes in the passenger side of the vehicle. Several shell casings were also recovered in the street. A witness pointed to a female who was driving the car at the time it was fired upon, but the female was uncooperative and denied ever being inside of the vehicle. The vehicle was towed from the scene so it could be processed by our Mobile Crime Unit. **Witnesses at the scene**

stated the shots came from a blue SUV (no further information or license plate).

**8/21/15 Aggravated Assault (Shooting) – 7000 block Bennett Street, 2:40pm.** A 24 year-old victim was shot in the back at this location. He was transported to UPMC Presbyterian Hospital where he was in stable condition. Based on the description given to officers, we have a strong suspect in the case but the name is being withheld until we can confirm this is our shooter. **8/21/15 Burglary – 2500 block Park Hill Drive, 2:15pm.** Victim reports she was at home when her **15 year-old grandson (address unknown)** climbed through a rear patio window and entered her residence. He then stole the victim's wallet containing cash and credit cards, then fled on foot. Officers will obtain an arrest warrant for the juvenile suspect. *He will be charged with burglary.* (157347)

**8/23/15 Aggravated Assault (On Police Officer) / PFA Violation – N. Homewood Avenue & Frankstown Avenue, 1:25am.** Officers noticed a 34 year-old victim who appeared to be in some sort of distress at the above location. Upon speaking with the victim, officers learned that she has a PFA against her ex-boyfriend, **Gregory Moore, 43, of Homewood**, who had just approached her and spit on her. Officers attempted to arrest Moore for the PFA violation. Moore appeared highly intoxicated and attempted to leave the area, refusing to listen to officers. Suddenly, Moore turned around and charged at one of the officers. During the ensuing scuffle, Moore bit one of the officers, breaking his skin. Eventually, officers were able to get Moore into handcuffs. He was transported to UPMC Presbyterian for medical clearance, then taken to jail. *Moore was charged with PFA Violation, Aggravated Assault on Police, Resisting Arrest, Public Drunkenness, and Harassment (for spitting on the victim).*

**8/23/15 Robbery – Frankstown Avenue & N. Homewood Avenue, 5:50pm.** A 50 year-old female victim reports that an unknown male snatched money from her hand and fled on foot. Officers quickly flooded the area and stopped a man matching the description given by the victim. The victim was brought to the scene and immediately identified the male, **Anthony Douglas Rose, 31, of Homewood**, as the man who robbed her. Rose was also in possession of marijuana at the time of his arrest. *He was charged with Robbery and Possession of a Small Amount of Marijuana.*

**8/17/15 Burglary – 6500 block Rowan Street, Occurred between 2:00pm and 6:00pm.** A 77 year-old male victim reports that he returned home to find his window A/C unit had been removed. **8/18/15 Burglary – Cambria Court – East Liberty Gardens, 2:00am.** Officers responded to a burglary-in-progress in East Liberty Gardens and arrived on scene to find a rear sliding glass door had been shattered. As officers waited for back-up in order to clear the apartment, **Efrem George Allen, 23, of Garfield**, emerged from the residence and fled. Officers gave chase and were able to arrest Allen without a struggle near the Target store. Allen discarded a crow bar as he fled, but officers were able to recover it as evidence. Officers learned that Allen broke into the residence and attempted to steal clothing, DVD's, and a Playstation. *Allen was charged with Burglary and Possessing Instruments of a Crime (crow bar).* (154843)

### **Notable Arrests**

**8/18/15 at 6:00pm – 1200 block Ferris Court (Homewood):** Zone 5 VPI (Violence Prevention & Intelligence) officers were conducting surveillance in the 1200 block of Ferris Court when they witnessed **Malik Mollett, 18, of Homewood**, behaving in a suspicious manner. Specifically, when Mollett spotted the officers, he distanced himself from his friends and discarded something near a basement window well, then reappeared. Officers stopped to speak with Mollett, at which point he admitted that he had some marijuana on him. Officers placed him in handcuffs and went to the window well and discovered a loaded Walther PPK .32 cal pistol. Mollett eventually admitted that he was carrying the gun. Mollett was charged with Possession of Marijuana, Possession with Intent to Deliver Marijuana, and Firearms Not to be Carried without a License. (155322)

**8/21/15 at 2:00pm – 1800 block Maplewood Street (East Hills):** Zone 5 VPI officers received a tip from a community member that Deshawn Hall (the suspect from the homicide on Fahnestock Street on 8/19) was inside of a residence in this block. Officers immediately responded to the area and setup a perimeter around the house in question. Three individuals inside of the house exited and stated that nobody else was inside. The homeowner agreed to let officers walk through the house to confirm that nobody else was inside. While doing so, officers smelled an odor of marijuana and saw drug paraphernalia and packaging materials lying around in plain sight. Officers cleared the residence to ensure nobody was hiding inside. then applied for a search warrant based on the items they saw inside the house. After securing a warrant, a detailed search of the premises was conducted and officers recovered the following items:

- (2) Smith & Wesson .40 cal pistols, one of which was reported stolen.
- (1) Kel-Tec 9mm pistol which was reported stolen.
- (1) Kassnar Defender .25 cal pistol
- (1) H&R model 1906 .22cal revolver
- (8) Bags of marijuana
- (2) Bags of ammunition
- (8) "bundles" of heroin

The homeowner, **Roberta James, 49, of East Hills**, was arrested. *She was charged with Receiving Stolen Property (guns), and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.* **Ronika Lewis-Miller, 21, of East Hills**, was also arrested. *She was charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance and Possession with Intent to Deliver a Controlled Substance.* A warrant will be issued for **Aaron James, 26, of East Hills**. *He will be charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance, Possession with Intent to Deliver a Controlled Substance, Receiving Stolen Property (guns), and Persons Not to Possess Firearms.* (157447)
