
Knox Room in Long Hall Campus of the Pittsburgh Theological Seminary

ACTION-Housing has been selected by the Board of Directors of the Pittsburgh Theological Seminary to redevelop three apartment buildings at Highland and Stanton Avenues. The 54 units are located in the Highlander, McMillan and Anderson buildings, originally built in the mid-20th century as housing for students and employees of the Seminary. As part of the current master planning process, the Seminary decided to make these buildings available to a developer who would create new affordable units. Through a Request for Proposal process in the fall of 2019, ACTION-Housing was selected with a plan that fully renovates the buildings for use as affordable and supportive housing, the majority of which will be available to the general public starting later in 2020.

If you would like to hear more about the project and have a chance to talk with the developers about their plans for the buildings and site, please plan on attending the initial community meeting on Tuesday, February 25 from 5:30 to 6:30. You'll have a chance to hear about the renovation plans, affordability goals and construction schedule. Lite refreshments will be served.
