Homewood / East Hills

7/5/16 Theft from Vehicle – Frankstown Avenue & Enterprise Street. Victim reported that his car was towed to this location following a crash. When the victim went to retrieve his vehicle, he found that tools, a laptop, and a digital camera had been taken. It should be noted that the victim's car door had been removed by rescue personnel during the crash. (124958)

7/6/16 Robbery – 7100 block Bennett Street, 4:30 PM. A 9 year-old male victim reported that he was riding his bicycle near the Homewood YMCA when an unknown male pushed him off of his bicycle and rode off with it. The suspect is a **black male, 13-14 years old, with a "box" haircut, wearing blue shorts and a gray t-shirt.** The bicycle that was stolen is a **red & black Humphrey bicycle.** (125676)

7/8/16 Carjacking – Bracey Court, 4:00 PM. A 39 year old female victim reported that she gave a ride to an unknown male from North Versailles to East Hills. Upon arriving in East Hills, this unknown male forcibly removed the victim from her vehicle and drove off in her 2000 burgundy Jeep Grand Cherokee (PA Plate JJW 6118). (126889)

7/10/16 Robbery – 600 block N. Homewood Avenue, 12:10 PM. A 50 year-old male victim reported that he was working as a jitney driver when an unknown assailant walked into the jitney stand with a knife and demanded money. The victim refused and pushed the robber out of the store. The robber fled the scene. The suspect was described as a **black male, 20-25, 5'7", 180 Lbs, bald, stocky, clean shaven, with a brown complexion.** (128083)

7/5/16 Arson – Larimer Avenue & Joseph Street, 2:15 AM. Officers responded to a car fire and found a white Mercedes Benz fully engulfed in flames. There were no injuries but a gas can was found by the vehicle. Arson Squad is investigating. (124585)

Officers responded to a violent family domestic and arrived to find a 59 year-old male victim bleeding from the neck and face. The victim indicated that he was stabbed in the neck by **Leeshay Wagner, 21, of Garfield**. Wagner was still on scene and was placed under arrest. Officer were also able to recover the knife used in the stabbing. The victim was transported to West Penn Hospital in stable condition. (124609)

The victim chased after the suspects who were described as **black males, under 18, thin builds, all in swimsuits**, but lost sight of them. A red purse was stolen from the victim’s vehicle. 7/6/16 Aggravated Assault – 7340 Butler Street, 1:15 PM. A 9 year-old male victim indicated that a classmate punched him in the face, breaking a tooth and splitting his lip. **The suspect is a known male, 12-14 years old.** Officers will file charges through Juvenile Court. (126200)

7/9/16 Stolen Vehicle – 1100 block Heberton Street. Officers responded to Heberton Street & Bryant Street for a stolen vehicle that had just crashed into some bushes. Officers arrived to find a silver Toyota Camry up on the sidewalk, unoccupied. A neighbor reported that three young black males had just fled from the vehicle. The victim was located and recovered his vehicle. (127684)

7/9/16 Stolen Vehicle – 1800 block Morningside Avenue. Victim reported his 2011 white Nissan Rogue (PA Plate JPF-1140) was stolen from his driveway. (127397)

7/9/16 Robbery – 877 Freeport Road (Waterworks Mall), 3:45 PM. A 16 year-old female victim came to Zone 5 station to report that she had been robbed in the Waterworks Mall parking lot 90 minutes earlier. The victim stated that an unknown male was trying to get her attention but she continued to walk away. The male caught up to her and asked for money. When the victim opened her wallet to see how much money she had, the suspect snatched the money and walked away. The suspect is a black male, 40-50, 5'11" 180 Lbs, clean shaven, with missing or broken teeth. He was wearing a brown shirt and black baggy pants. (127593)

7/10/16 Stolen Vehicle – 700 block N. Beatty Street. Victim reported that someone stole his 2012 silver Jeep Patriot (PA Plate JZD-8315). Victim has the only key in his possession and stated that the vehicle is paid-off so it would not have been repossessed. (128039)



Notable Arrests

7/3/16 at 10:24 AM – Washington Blvd & Allegheny River Blvd (Highland Park): Zone 5 Officer Chris Mosesso conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle that was driving at a high rate of speed. Upon speaking with the driver, **Daquon Malik Enoch, 21, of the West End**, Officer Mosesso smelled a strong odor of marijuana. Additionally, Enoch did not have a driver's license. The vehicle was searched with nothing recovered initially, and Enoch was advised that he could leave but the vehicle was going to be towed. After Enoch left the area, officers noticed that the center console appeared to have been tampered with. Upon a more in-depth search, officers found a Glock model 23 pistol hidden in an area beneath the center console. They also found (531) stamp bags of heroin, marijuana, and \$2000.00 cash. A check of Enoch through the police computer found that he does not possess a license to carry a firearm and is prohibited from possessing any firearms based on his criminal history. Officers will obtain an arrest warrant for Daquon Malik Enoch. (123444)

7/8/16 at 6:11am – 7300 block Kelly Street (Homewood): Zone 5 VPI officers Aaron Spangler and Chris Joliet secured a search warrant for a residence following a drug investigation. Based on information received during the investigation, officers utilized PGH SWAT to serve the warrant. Upon serving the warrant, officers found (5) individuals inside the residence. During a search of the residence, officers recovered crack cocaine, Xanax, heroin, digital scales, and packaging materials. Officers arrested **Amir Rasgaad Donte Page, 24, and Charline Georgia, 39, both of Homewood.** (126675)
