- Deliver substantial economic benefits to Allegheny County
- Gain useful and valuable new skills

Every tax season, the United Way of Allegheny County and the Money In Your Pocket Coalition train and mobilize community volunteers like you to provide free, quality income-tax preparation assistance to families earning less than \$40,000 and individuals making less than \$20,000 a year.

Many of our neighbors don't have access to affordable tax help, fall victim to "rapid refund" loans, or are unaware of state and federal tax credits like the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) that can put thousands of dollars into their pockets.

That's money that can be used to put food on the table, pay monthly utility bills, purchase gasoline or bus passes, make rent payments, or eliminate personal debt.

In 2010, more than 125 volunteers dedicated over 4,000 hours to the free tax campaign. Volunteers prepared 4,486 tax returns and helped return \$7.8 million in tax refunds back to the community, including \$3.1 million in Earned Income Tax Credits.
