Negley Avenue at Stanton Avenue, Northbound approach

Negley Avenue at Stanton Avenue, Districts 7 and 9– This traffic signal replacement project is in the East Liberty and Highland Park neighborhoods.

This project consists of a complete replacement of the traffic signal which will include new strain poles, pedestrian countdown signal heads with audible push buttons, LED vehicular signal heads, dedicated left turn signals and LED streetlights.

This project will add left turn lanes to both approaches of Negley Avenue in response to historical crash data and turning movement counts. These left turn movements will be provided with a protected turning phase.

This project is expected to begin construction in Winter 2022 and reach completion by Spring 2022.
