Homewood / East Hills

3/20/16 Robbery – 2100 block Park Hill Drive, 9:20pm. A 13 year-old male victim reported that **several known suspect, all between the ages of 12-15**, attacked him. One of the boys had a gun and struck the victim with it, causing facial injuries. The boys then stole cash, jewelry, and the victim's jacket. The boys then fled the scene. Zone 5 detectives are investigating. (50339)

3/21/16 Aggravated Assault (Domestic) – 2200 block Wilner Drive, 7:44am. Officers responded to a domestic violence call and found **Karen Stanton, 22, of East Hills**, with facial injuries. The male half, **Jamal Woods-Stubbs, 22, of Penn Hills**, left the scene prior to police arrival. Officers later encountered Woods-Stubbs and found that he had been stabbed in the back and shoulder. Woods-Stubbs was taken to the hospital for treatment, then arrested for domestic violence. Officers are obtaining an arrest warrant for Stanton for stabbing Woods-Stubbs. She will be charged with Aggravated Assault. (50526)

3/23/16 Aggravated Assault (Fight) – 6900 block Frankstown Avenue, 6:30pm. A 14 year-old male victim was involved in a fight with some known teenage males from the neighborhood. According to witnesses, one of the other teens struck the victim on the head with a blunt object during the fight and he was knocked unconscious. The victim had a seizure and was transported to the hospital, initially in critical condition. The victim has since been stabilized. Detectives are interviewing witnesses and will obtain arrest warrant(s) once the suspect has been positively identified. (52223)

3/24/16 Aggravated Assault (Threat with a Firearm) – Hamilton Avenue & Albion Street, 5:06pm. A 53 year-old female victim reported that she was involved in a verbal altercation with a known male. The altercation became physical at which point others got involved. The male suspect pulled a firearm from his waistband and threatened to shoot the victim. Shortly thereafter, the suspect handed the gun off to someone else who took it inside of "The Spot." Officers were subsequently able to recover the CZ P-07 9mm pistol from "The Spot" and placed the male suspect under arrest. The suspect was identified as **Raymond Martin Walker, 55, of Homewood**. Officers also learned that the gun was reported stolen from the Zone 4 area and, additionally, Walker was prohibited from possessing firearms because of his criminal history. Walker was transported to the ACJ. (52870)

3/26/16 Burglary – 2200 block East Hills Drive, Occurred between 2:00pm and 8:00pm. Victim reported she returned home to find her back door kicked-in and her 32" LCD TV, Xbox 360, and Phillips sound bar had all been stolen. (54390)

Larimer / Lincoln-Lemington

3/21/16 Theft from Vehicle – Indiana Way & Pace Way, 2:00pm. Victim is with JML Landscaping and reported that (2) leaf blowers were stolen from an unlocked work truck when it was briefly left unattended. (50712)

3/21/16 Stolen Car – Lyric Street & Lincoln Avenue. Victim came to Zone 5 to report his **gray 2005 Volkswagen Jetta (PA Plate JWK-2193)** had been stolen from the above location. The victim told officers he noticed his ignition key was missing from his keychain but had no idea where it went. (52036)

3/23/16 Carjacking – 7100 block Campania Street, 11:43pm. A 27 year-old male victim reported that he and his girlfriend were driving on Campania Street. While stopped, an unknown male suspect approached the driver's side of the car holding a black pistol and ordered the victims out of the vehicle. The victims complied and the male drove off in the vehicle, which was later recovered by police (unoccupied). **The suspect is a black male, late teens – early 20's, 5'6" tall, medium build, brown complexion, medium length "plaits" in his hair, tattoo on his cheek, possibly of a cross.** (52395)

Bloomfield/Garfield/Friendship

3/22/16 Stolen Car – Shadyside Honda – 5121 Liberty Avenue, 11:30am. Victim reported that a **2013 green/blue Honda CRV (No license plate / VIN # 5J6RM4H75DL039962)** was stolen from inside their service garage. It is believed that someone entered the garage unnoticed and stole the vehicle. (51393)

3/22/16 Theft from Vehicle – 100 block N. Winebiddle Street, 12:00pm. Victim is a Comcast employee who reported that an unknown suspect stole (2) DeWalt power drills from his unlocked work truck when he briefly left the vehicle unattended. (51261)

3/22/16 Burglary – 500 block Dargan Street, Occurred between 3/17 at 5:30pm and 3/22 at 2:00pm. Victim reported someone broke into the property and spray painted the walls and doors. The words "Zoey" and "IGLOO." (51974)

3/25/16 Theft from Vehicle – 700 block Gross Street. Victim reported he parked his car and went into work. A few minutes later he returned to his car after realizing he forgot his wallet. The victim found his wallet laying open on the driver's seat and the money was missing. No signs of forced entry. (53345)

Stanton Heights/Morningside/Highland Park/East Liberty

3/21/16 Stolen Car – 4800 block Stanton Avenue. Victim reported his 2012 silver Acura TL (PA Plate ENZ-0099) was stolen overnight. The vehicle was unlocked and a spare set of keys was in the center console. (50537)

3/24/16 Theft from Vehicle – 900 block N. Highland Avenue. Victim reported that his Ray Ban sunglasses were stolen from his vehicle that was possibly left unlocked. (52970)

3/25/16 Aggravated Assault – 400 block N. Beatty Street, 12:45pm. A 45 year-old female victim reports that she was visiting a friend when the two began to argue. A fight ensued at which point the friend, **Jacqueline Finney, 51, of East Liberty,** struck the victim in the head with a lamp. The victim sustained a deep laceration with serious bleeding. She was taken to UPMC Presbyterian in serious condition but is expected to recover. Finney was arrested and charged with Aggravated Assault. (53447)

3/26/16 Robbery (Domestic) – 300 block N. Aiken Avenue, 2:09am. A 36 year-old female victim reported that her ex-boyfriend robbed her. The victim was uncooperative and refused to give police her ex-boyfriend's name, but stated that they were at a friend's house together and her ex walked her home afterwards. Once they reached the victim's house, the ex-boyfriend grabbed her bag and fled. The bag allegedly contained over \$500.09 cash and (2) cell phones. The victim called the police because she wanted her money back but did not want to press charges against her ex. Because of the PA domestic violence laws, we are obligated to make an arrest and our officers are working to learn the identity of the ex-boyfriend. (53925)

3/27/16 Aggravated Assault (Domestic) – 600 block Sheridan Avenue, 1:54am. Officers responded to a neighbor's call for a violent domestic in the apartment above hers. Officers arrived on scene to find broken wine bottles on the sidewalk and a male throwing items out of the house. When officers exited their vehicles, the male, **Tyrese Gilbert, 31, of the West End,** ran into the house and locked the door. Officers instructed Gilbert to exit the house several times but he was openly defiant and challenged officers. Officers forced entry and subdued Gilbert after a struggle. Officers found Gilbert's 27 year-old girlfriend and 1 year-old daughter were unharmed. Gilbert was charged with Aggravated Assault on a Police Officer, Endangering the Welfare of a Child, and Resisting Arrest. (54596)
