Homewood / East Hills

7/20/15 Burglary - 1000 block Beecher Street, Occurred between 7/18 at 4:30pm and 7/20 at 11:30am. Victim reports her front window was forced open and an LG flat screen TV as well as several pair of tennis shoes had been stolen. (133920)

7/23/15 Aggravated Assault (Domestic) – 2105 Park Hill Drive, 2:15pm. A 22 year-old male victim reports that his girlfriend struck him over the head with a shovel twice, causing lacerations and bruising. The suspect was identified as **Christine Jackson, 21, of East Hills.** Officers will obtain an arrest warrant for Jackson. *She will be charged with Aggravated Assault.* (136374)

7/23/15 Burglary (Landlord/Tenant Dispute) – 7300 block Hermitage Street, 10:40am. The victim is the landlord of the property who evicted her tenant several weeks ago. She returned to the property today to find signs of forced entry. All of her previous tenant's belongings had been placed back in the residence. This investigation is ongoing. (136247)

7/23/15 Attempted Burglary – 8320 Frankstown Avenue (Levels Convenient Store), Occurred between 7/22 at 11:00pm and 7/23 at 7:45am. Victim reports he arrived to work to find someone had attempted to make entry to the store. No entry was made. (136172)

7/24/15 Burglary (Domestic) – 7000 block Fletcher Way, 2:20am. A 25 year-old female victim reports that her ex-boyfriend entered her house by climbing through an open window, then assaulted her. The suspect was identified as **Stanley Broadus, 25, of Homewood.** Officers were able to locate Broadus on Monticello Street and arrested him without incident. *Broadus was charged with Burglary and Simple Assault.* (136840).

7/24/15 Aggravated Assault – 7300 block Idlewild Street – 3:43pm – A 19 year-old male victim was shot multiple times. His friends were transporting him to a hospital when, at Kelly and Sterrett Streets, they were again shot at but no persons were hit. Victim is in stable condition. (137184)

Larimer / Lincoln-Lemington

7/20/15 Aggravated Assault (Stabbing) – 6900 block Lemington Avenue, 8:45pm. A 51 year-old male victim was stabbed numerous times in the abdomen following a fight with a known suspect. The victim was taken to UPMC Presbyterian in serious condition but is expected to recover. The suspect has been identified as **Gregory Bailey, 57, of Lincoln-Lemington**. Officers will obtain an arrest warrant for Bailey. *He will be charged with Aggravated Assault.* (134343)

7/22/15 Burglary – 1200 block Pointview Street, 12:15pm. Victim reports that he returned home to find forced entry to his home and two unknown suspects inside of his residence. The suspects fled when the victim arrived home. One suspect fled on foot. The other suspect fled in a silver BMW with a tinted rear window. **Suspect # 1 is described as a black male, 25-30 years old, large build, about 230 Lbs, with a goatee and medium length dreadlocks. Suspect # 2 is described as a black male, 25 years old, 6'0" 160 Lbs.** (135549)

7/23/15 Burglary –6300 block St. Marie Street. Victim reports a wireless router was stolen. Victim last saw it on 7/14/15 and reported it missing on 7/23/15. No forced entry. (136685)

7/25/15 Robbery – 100 block Auburn Street. A known suspect grabbed car keys from the victim's hand. This is a domestic violence incident and the officer will obtain an arrest warrant. (137157)

Bloomfield/Garfield/Friendship

7/20/15 Burglary - 200 block Fern Street, Occurred on 7/19 between 1:00pm and 4:00pm. Victim reports someone entered an unlocked bedroom window and stole his 55" flat screen TV. Victim believes the actor is a family member and resulted from a family fight. (133947)

7/24/15 Burglary (Business) – 5107 Penn Ave, 1:50am. Officers responded to an alarm and found the front door glass broken and the front cash register missing. Suspect(s) used a hammer to break the glass and steal the cash register that contained \$400. (136812)

7/26/15 Aggravated Assault – 4700 block Liberty Ave, 4:38am. Victim was assaulted by her boyfriend, resulting in a laceration to her head. Medics advised the victim that she needs stitches but the victim refused medical treatment. Officers will apply for an arrest warrant. (138495)

Stanton Heights/Morningside/Highland Park/East Liberty

7/20/15 Burglary – 100 block Elena Court, 10:00pm. The victim reports that he was notified of a burglar alarm going off at his house. He returned home to find his front door open and the following items missing: 32" flat screen TV, a Sony PlayStation, and a Tiger Woods video game. Victim reports that he left his front door unlocked. (134402)

7/21/15 Burglary – 6401 Penn Avenue, Occurred between 7/17 at 3:30pm and 7/20 at 6:30am. Ballymoney Real Estate reports that their property was burglarized and a subcontractor had the following items stolen: Two weed whackers, leaf blower, vacuum, hedge trimmers, and 100 feet of copper pipe. 7/23/15 Burglary – 1000 block King Avenue, Occurred between 7/21 at 6:00pm and 7/23 at 3:00pm. Victim reports a backpack was stolen from her garage. It should be noted that the victim had painters working on her house who were in and out of the garage. (136396)

7/23/15 Theft from Vehicle – 300 block S. Negley Avenue, Occurred between 7/22 at 6:00pm and 7/23 at 4:45pm. Victim reports his hunting knife and some cash was stolen from his unlocked vehicle. (136471)

7/23/15 Aggravated Assault – 6010 Broad Street (Barber Shop), 5:00pm. A 34 year-old victim reports that a known suspect came up from behind him and struck him in the head with a hard object while he was at work in the barber shop. The victim identified the suspect as **Antonio Laron Hardin, 21, of Lincoln-Lemington**. The victim further stated that Hardin was recently fired from the barber shop and the victim was the person who had to tell him he was fired. Officers will obtain an arrest warrant for Hardin. He will be charged with Aggravated Assault. (136467)

7/23/15 Theft From Vehicle – 100 block Stratford Avenue, Occurred between 10:00pm and Midnight. Unknown suspect's stole victim iPhone and money from her car. (137065)

7/23/15 Theft from Vehicle – 300 block Stratford Avenue, Occurred between 10:00pm and 2:00pm. Victim's vehicle was unlocked. An unknown suspect stole dog food and dog treats (137131)

7/24/15 Robbery – 6400 Penn Avenue, 1:30pm. The victim is a delivery driver (bicyclist). He was on his bicycle on a dirt path that goes along the Village of Shadyside

condominiums. While on the path an unknown suspect pulled out a black handgun, pointed it at the victim and demanded money. The victim gave the suspect his money at which point the actor demanded more, so the victim gave the suspect his phone. The victim did not believe the suspect knew he was a delivery driver. (137132)

7/25/15 Theft from Vehicle – 900 block 56th Street, Occurred between 10:00pm and 6:00am. Victim reported that his sunglasses and \$15.00 in change were stolen from his vehicle. (138557)



Notable Arrests

7/20/15: Zone 5 officers and detectives were conducting a foot patrol of the East Liberty Gardens housing complex in response to complaints of loitering and drug dealing on the property. The officers encountered **Shakele S. Johnson, 20, of East Hills** loitering by the ball field. Johnson was found to be in possession of marijuana and crack cocaine, and was placed under arrest. *Johnson will be charged with (2) counts of Possession of a Controlled Substance.* (134227)

7/20/15: Zone 5 officers responded to the 4700 block of Farmington Street in Stanton Heights for a report of several men armed with rifles. Officers encountered (7) males as they were attempting to leave the area and detained them without incident. The rifles were found to be paintball guns. The officers checked the area and found no property damage and no victims who reported being injured by paintball rounds. Officers did arrest one of the males, **Maurre Clemm, 19, of East Liberty**, after he was found to be in possession of marijuana. *Clemm was charged (via summons) with Possession of a Small Amount of Marijuana.* (134445)

7/21/15: Zone 5 plainclothes detectives were investigating the theft of an iPad and were able to track it to an address in the 7400 block of Race Street, in Homewood. The detectives are familiar with this address and know it to be a hangout for violent individuals known to carry firearms. Because of this, they requested assistance from Pittsburgh SWAT to execute the warrant. (This was done because our SWAT team

utilizes special equipment that allows them to execute warrants in a manner that is safer for everybody, both the police and the targets of the warrant). Upon serving the warrant, numerous individuals were located inside the house. While searching the location, detectives recovered a stolen Taurus PT140 .40 cal pistol, a stolen Smith & Wesson .38 cal revolver, and a Glock model 23 .40 cal pistol in the residence. Detectives also recovered marijuana. The following individuals were arrested: **Aqeel Daniels, 23, of Homewood, Terrell Scott, 25, of Verona, and Thomas Howard-Goins, 19, of Homewood.** *These males were all charged with felony firearms violations, among other crimes.* (135024)

7/24/15: Zone 5 plainclothes detectives arrested **Jerome Pleasant-Simpson, 20, of Penn Hills,** for felony firearms violations during a traffic stop. It should be noted that Pleasant-Simpson was the victim of a shooting on 2/3/15 at 7101 Frankstown Ave. Pleasant-Simpson and was uncooperative with police at that time. (136796)

7/26/15: East Liberty Blvd & Hamilton – Zone 5 officers received a 911 call for a possible stolen vehicle in the area. The officers located the vehicle and made a traffic stop. The driver stopped the car and immediately fled on foot. Officers pursued the suspect on foot and tackled him in an attempt to take him into custody. The suspect continued to resist arrest, causing the officers to use additional force to get him handcuffed. The suspect was identified as Mark Venson, 22, of the Hill District. (138315)
