Homewood / East Hills

10/16/16 Stolen Vehicle – 7900 block Tacoma Street, 7:25 PM. Victim reported that she left her vehicle running momentarily when she ran inside her house to grab her purse. When she came back outside, she witnessed her white Hyunda Azera being driven down the street, occupied by two unknown black males in black hooded sweatshirts. The driver crashed her vehicle into three parked cars before fleeing on foot. (195803)

10/19/16 Burglary – 700 block Wilksburg Avenue. A Sony PlayStation, clothing, and liquor were stolen. The victims suspect a former friend of committing the crime. (197660)

10/21/16 Burglary – 7300 block Frankstown Avenue, 12:00 PM. A 52 year-old male victim told responding officers that he had four people over last night for a party. The individuals left at 8:00 AM but came back at noon and kicked-in his back door. One of them punched the victim in the eye. The victim believed the assault was about drugs. He does not know the identity of the individuals who were drinking in his apartment last night. (198846)

10/22/16 Homicide (Shooting) - 7100 block Upland Street. Officers responded to a call for a male that was found face-down in an area of high grass. Responding officers found a 19 year-old male victim who had been shot multiple times and was deceased. It should be noted that there was an activation of the ShotSpotter system in that area the previous night but officers were unable to find anything at that time. VCU (Violent Crime Unit) is investigating. (199389)

10/22/16 Robbery – Kelly Street & Collier Street, 6:45 AM. A 26 year-old female victim reported that she met a male named "Mike" at a house party around midnight. Shortly before 7:00 AM, "Mike" and the victim were walking down the street when "Mike" began choking her before stealing \$45.00 from her bra and fleeing. Zone 5 detectives are working to learn the identity of "Mike." (199350)

Larimer / Lincoln-Lemington

10/19/16 Burglary – 6508 Frankstown Avenue (Jackson-Hewitt). Sometime between 5/10/16 and 10/19/16, an unknown suspect broke into the business and stole copper pipes and (6) Dell computer systems. (197592)

10/19/16 Burglary / Simple Assault (Domestic) – 1500 block Lincoln Avenue, 9:33 PM. A 26 year-old female victim indicated that she became involved in a verbal argument with her child's father when he began to physically assault her. The victim left the scene and went to a family member's house. When she returned home later that night, she saw her child's father, **Treyvon Allen Perry, 21, of Lincoln-Lemington and his brother, Thomas Eugene Perry, 32, of Lincoln-Lemington,** walking away from her

residence. When she went inside, the victim found all of her windows smashed-out and entry had been made into the house. Officers are obtaining arrest warrants for Treyvon and Thomas Perry. (197869)

10/20/16 Stolen Vehicle – 6400 block Frankstown Avenue. Victim reported that he pulled into the Sunoco to get gas. He left his car running as he went into the store to buy cigarettes. When he came out, his car was gone. The vehicle is a **2010 silver Subaru Outback (PA plate KDF-6013)**. (198295)

10/23/16 Theft from Vehicle – Lincoln Avenue & Frankstown Avenue. This victim is a jitney driver who stated that when he stopped for gas, his passengers exited the vehicle and walked away. Upon checking his glove box, the victim found his firearm was missing. (200112)

10/18/16 Theft from Vehicle – 300 block Roup Avenue. (196721)

10/18/16 Robbery – 200 block Fern Street, 8:00 PM. A 16 year-old female victim reported that she answered an ad on a website called "OfferUp" and agreed to purchase an Apple iPhone from a man for \$220.00. When the victim arrived at the meeting location, the individual instead robbed her at gunpoint and took her money. The victim recognized the suspect as a male she knows as **"Dion," from the neighborhood**. Detectives will obtain a warrant once they confirm Dion's full identity. (197160)

10/18/16 Aggravated Assault – 5100 block Hillcrest Street, 8:10 PM. Officers went to West Penn Hospital ER to take an assault report and spoke with a 37 year-old female victim who stated that she and her 38 year-old sister were assaulted earlier in the night near Ft. Pitt Elementary School. The suspects were a group of 5-10 men and women, all between 20-30 years of age. The victims did not know the suspect's names, but recognized them as parents of other neighborhood kids and stated that they have seen them at football games at Ft. Pitt field. This incident apparently stemmed from an earlier incident (not reported to police) where the victim's child was involved in a physical altercation with another student. The victims were punched, kicked, and sustained bruises and possible broken bones. They were awaiting X-rays at the time of the report. Zone 5 plainclothes detectives will be handling this case. (197193)

10/18/16 Robbery (Home Invasion) - 500 block S. Mathilda Street, 10:24 PM. The victims, 26 and 28-year old brothers, told police that two men with guns forced their way into their house and demanded to know where their guns and money were located. According to the victim's, the suspects assaulted them, grabbed a safe, then fled. Detectives reviewed security camera footage at the residence and immediately recognized the two men as **DeShaun Evans-Connor, 20, and Malik Williams, 23, of East Hills**. The driver of the getaway vehicle was also identified as **Ryan Hart, 20, of Maryland**. All of these men were located and arrested within 24 hours. They are in the Allegheny County Jail. (198295)

10/19/16 Robbery (Domestic) - 5100 block Schenley Avenue, 9:25 PM. A 22 year-old female victim reported that her ex-fiancee, **Olyver Gardner, 22, of East Hills**, came to her house to get some belongings. While there, an argument ensued and Gardner grabbed the victim and removed her engagement ring by force. He then jumped onto her car and smashed the windshield, then punched the victim several times. Gardner fled before officers arrived but a warrant will be obtained for his arrest. (197881)

10/19/16 Stolen Motorcycle – 300 block 40th Street. A 1977 Grey Punch moped (PA plate BP-126) was stolen from the parking lot across from the victim's home. (198356)

Security camera footage showed a black male (15-23 years old) in a black Nike hooded sweatshirt and red sweatpants throwing a red brick through the store window. The suspect then entered the store and grabbed some clothing before fleeing. (199842)

10/17/16 Robbery – 6100 block Broad Street, 3:36 PM. A 47 year-old male victim reported that he was walking in an alleyway near the 6100 block of Broad Street when four unknown males jumped out from behind a parked van. Two of the males were pointing guns at him and demanded his belongings. The suspects took his phone and a small amount of cash, then fled towards Home Depot. The only description was four young black males, one in an orange hooded sweatshirt with a black mask on his face, and one in a sky blue hooded sweatshirt. The victim was not injured. (196303)

Notable Arrests

10/18/16 at 8:20 PM – 4400 block Liberty Avenue (Bloomfield): Pittsburgh Police Narcotics detectives conducted an undercover drug operation, during which time they arranged to purchase (3) "bricks" of heroin (150 stamp bags) from an unknown drug dealer in the area. When the dealer arrived in the area, detectives attempted to take him into custody. **Jerome Portis, 20, of Bloomfield**, fled from detectives but was arrested after a short foot pursuit. After taking Portis into custody, detectives recovered the (3) bricks of heroin from Portis. Portis was charged with felony drug offenses and taken to the ACJ. (197167)

10/19/16 at 3:00 PM – 4602 Liberty Avenue (Bloomfield): Pittsburgh Police Narcotics detectives conducted an undercover drug operation during time which they observed **Rashawn Hall, 34, of Lincoln-Lemington**, deliver crack cocaine to a female in the 4600 block of Liberty Avenue. A short time later, detectives detained Hall, at which point they found him to be in possession of several baggies of crack cocaine. Hall was arrested and charged with felony drug offenses. (197679)

10/21/16 at 12:30 AM – Schenley Avenue & Columbo Street (Garfield): Officers Erevia and Patton were patrolling the area when they came across a stolen Chrysler Sebring. Officers stopped the vehicle and arrested the driver, **Harold Scott, 52, of Wilksburg**, without incident. Scott also had a warrant out for his arrest. (198550)

10/19/16 at 10:14 PM – Carver Street & Braden Way (Larimer): Officer Schrock was patrolling the area when he passed an orange Honda Element with several occupants as they were fueling the vehicle at the Sunoco gas station. An orange Honda Element was reported stolen a few days earlier and photos of the vehicle were posted at the police station. As officer Schrock turned around to confirm the license plate, the occupants fled from the vehicle. The driver, **Duston Cansler, 18, of East Liberty**, was apprehended by other officers and placed under arrest. (192178)

10/22/16 at 12:54 AM – 7100 block Lemington Avenue (Lincoln-Lemington): Officers Connors and Macioce responded to a domestic dispute between three brothers. While enroute to the call, Officers encountered one of the brothers, **Jamil Graham, 23, of Lincoln-Lemington**, at Westmoreland Street &

Somerset Street. Jamil had blood on his shirt but did not appear to be injured. The officers went to the residence and called out for the other brothers, but received no response. They observed an open door and clear signs that a struggle had taken place. Fearing one or both of the other brothers might be inside and seriously injured, the officers did a protective sweep of the residence. In doing so, the officers noticed heroin, crack cocaine, powdered cocaine, and ammunition in plain view around the house. The other brothers were not in the house but one of them, **Leonard Morris-Graham, 24, of Lincoln-Lemington**, was found a short time later. Both Jamil and Leonard were placed under arrest for domestic violence and felony drug offenses. A warrant will be issued for the third brother, **Jamal Graham, 23, of Lincoln-Lemington**. (199225)
