Homewood / East Hills

11/14/16 Theft from Vehicle - N. Lang Avenue & Frankstown Avenue. Victim told officers that someone entered his car and took several bottles of cologne and left a set of car keys in his car. Victim pointed out a male across the street who was rummaging through a Hummer. Officers approached this male and eventually stopped him as he started walking away from them. When questioned by officers the male told them he was looking for his keys. When shown the keys the male said they were his but could not provide a reason why they were left in someone else's car. The male gave officers verbal consent to search him and Officers recovered the missing bottles of cologne from his pockets. **Marc Jones, 45, of the Northside,** was arrested for Receiving Stolen Property. 11/16/16 Burglary - 7515 Tioga Street (Abyssinian Capernaum Baptist Church). Victim told officers when he got to the church he noticed the front door was forced open. A 45 year-old male victim reported that **Deshawn Weathers, 46, of Penn Hills,** entered the bar and repeatedly struck him with a metal trailer hitch. Witnesses detained Weathers and officers arrested him as soon as they arrived on scene. The victim was taken to UPMC Presbyterian in fair condition. (217227)

11/19/16 Aggravated Assault (Shooting) - Race Street & Sterrett Street, 3:37 PM. A 50 year-old male victim walked to 17 Engine firehouse after he was shot in the back. The victim told firefighters that he was leaning into his vehicle when an **unknown black male wearing black pants, black jacket, and a black mask** began shooting towards him, striking him in the back. The victim was taken to UPMC Presbyterian in stable condition. (217919)

11/20/16 Robbery (Domestic) - 7400 block Monticello Street, 3:40 PM. A 29 year-old female victim reported that her ex-boyfriend, **Martel Dion Yates, 28, of Arnold (PA)**, picked her up at her house to go to the Family Dollar on Penn Avenue in Zone 4. While there, an argument ensued and Yates ended up snatching the victim's phone from her hand and fleeing. When the victim returned home, she found a briefcase that Yates left at the house when he came over. She opened it and found that it contained hundreds of heroin stamp bags. The victim called 911 and turned that bag over to police. Officers will issue a warrant for Yates and have already contacted his parole officer in an attempt to located him and have him picked-up. The actors then put a chrome revolver to the side of his head and ordered him to open the register. Suspects took cash out of the register, pulled the phone cord out of the wall, then fled. Only description is **two males between 18-30 years old, both about 6'1" tall.** (214801)

11/15/16 Shots Fired - Chislett Street & Bryant Street. Officers responded to the intersection of Chislett and Bryant for a ShotSpotter notification. A male told officers that he heard three shots and a flash from a light-colored sedan. No direction of flight provided for the vehicle. No victims located but (2) 9mm shell casings were recovered. 11/15/16 Robbery - Ipswich Court. Victim walked into Zone 5 station and told Officers he was delivering pizza from Pizza Parma to Ipswich Court. When the victim arrived on Ipswich Court he was approached by (3) black male teens. One of the males pulled out a silver semi-auto pistol and demanded the victim's money and phone. After turning over the cash, his phone and keys, the suspects fled the area. Suspect descriptions are as follows. **Suspect #1: black male, 5'4", slim build age 15-18 wearing all black. Suspect #2: black male, 5'4" wearing a black coat age 15-18. Suspect #3: black male, 5'9", slim build wearing gray hoodie age 15-18.** (215564)

11/16/16 Robbery - 200 block S. Euclid Avenue. Victim told officers that he was walking on S. Euclid past the Shell gas station when a **black male, age 25-30, 6' tall,** pulled a .38 caliber revolver and ordered him to the ground. The suspect told the man not to look up and asked for all his belongings. The victim gave up cash, his shoes, a black leather jacket, an iPhone 6, and several other items. Victim states the suspect appeared to be intoxicated. (215613)

smoke then saw smoke and fire in an area under the steps. All occupants safely exited the home. (216198)

Notable Arrests

11/16/16 at 1:31 AM - Zone 5 Officers were dispatched to an alarm activation at the Homewood branch of the Carnegie Library at 1:31 AM. Officers observed a side door ajar and an elevator door open and close on the front side of the building. Several minutes later the door opened and a male exited the elevator. Officers placed the male, **Rocky Bottoms, 57, Homeless**, into custody. Bottoms told Officers he was homeless and cold and went into the building to warm up. Officers then cleared the library and found no one else inside. (215602)

11/16/16 at 9:15 PM. Zone 5 Officers responded to Capri Pizza for a black male who had just fired (3) shots in the air. There were no victims, witnesses, or evidence recovered at Capri Pizza. Several minutes later the Port Authority Police initiated a traffic stop with bus 82L at Centre and S. Millvale. A male matching the description exited the bus and the Port Authority Police detained the individual and observed the handle of a firearm protruding from the male's jacket pocket. PAT Police handcuffed the suspect and recovered a .22 cal Burgo revolver. Zone 5 officers arrived on scene and learned the male,
