



**Community Crime Update**

**Homewood / East Hills**

**3/29/16 Aggravated Assault – Frankstown Avenue & Brushton Avenue, 8:00pm.** A 21 year-old female victim reported that a known suspect pulled up next to her while she was walking down the street and threw hot grease on her. The victim suffered burns to her head and face. Detectives will obtain a warrant after obtaining the suspects correct information. (56974)

**3/30/16 Shots Fired – 1000 block Wheeler Street, 1:14am.** Officers responded to a ShotSpotter alert, indicating that (4) shots had been fired in the area. Officers found (4) spent shell casings in the street but no people, homes, or cars had been struck by gunfire. (56503)

**3/30/16 Aggravated Assault (Stabbing) – 2100 block Park Hill Drive, 1:53am.** Officers responded to West Penn Hospital for a report of a female who had been stabbed. The 21 year-old female victim indicated that this happened earlier in the 2100 block of Park Hill Drive. The victim believes her ex-boyfriend's new girlfriend stabbed her during a fight involving several people, but she cannot be sure. Detectives are investigating. (56526)

**3/30/16 Burglary – 7900 block Inglebrook Street, 2:33pm.** A 40 year-old female victim reported that she was getting ready for work this morning and when she went into her bathroom, she found a man with a gun in her bathtub. The male fled without saying anything or taking anything. The victim was uninjured. **The suspect is a black male, 5'4" wearing a dark blue hooded sweatshirt.** (56877)

**3/30/16 Aggravated Assault (Shooting) – Brushton Ave & Race Street, 10:15pm.** Officers responded to a ShotSpotter alert and arrived to find (3) teenage males, all with non-life-threatening gunshot wounds. They were all transported to the hospital in stable condition. Detectives from our Group Violence Intervention (GVI) team are investigating. (52169)

**4/1/16 Stolen Car – 2500 block Park Hill Drive, 2:15am.** Victim reported that she awoke to the sound of her car being started. When she looked out the window, she could see someone driving off in her vehicle. Her car was later spotted by Penn Hill police, at which point the driver fled and led PHPD on a brief pursuit. All occupants fled from the car while it was moving and the car went over a hillside and crashed into a tree. The car was recovered but the suspects eluded capture. Victim reported she keeps a spare key in her car and that is most likely how the vehicle was stolen. (57998)

**4/1/16 Aggravated Assault (Shooting) – 7100 block Apple Avenue, 5:15pm.** Officers responded to a ShotSpotter alert in the area and arrived to find a 24 year-old male victim who stated that an unknown suspect began shooting at him. The victim stated he was walking on Apple Avenue when a **black male in his 20's, 6'3", thin build, wearing all black,** pointed a gun at him and began firing. The victim fled and jumped over a hillside. He was uninjured. The victim indicated that no words were exchanged and he has no clue who the suspect was or why he was firing at him. Several shell casings were recovered at the scene. (58454)

**4/2/16 Aggravated Assault (Domestic) – 7000 block Kedron Street, 1:15am.** A 34 year-old male victim reported that his girlfriend, **Marshall Hatch, 42, of Homewood,** hit him in the head with a shovel. Officers observed swelling and cuts to the victim's head. Hatch was on scene and was placed under arrest. (58747)

**4/2/16 Burglary – 1000 block Brushton Avenue, Occurred between 12:30pm and 6:40pm.** Victim reported someone broke into her apartment and stole an LCD TV and clothing. The victim believes her former roommate committed the burglary since the victim just had her evicted the previous day. (59246)

**4/3/16 Robbery (Domestic) – 2200 block Wilner Drive, 3:21pm.** A 27 year-old female victim reported that her ex-boyfriend, **Carl Jones, 25, of Homewood,** stopped by her house to talk. An argument ensued, at which point Jones became violent and choked the victim. The victim was able to get Jones out of the house and lock the door, but stated he kicked the door in and came back into the residence and continued assaulting her. Jones fled prior to police arrived. Officers will obtain an arrest warrant for Carl Jones. (59773)

**3/30/16 Stolen Vehicle – 1100 block Montezuma Street, 7:50am.** Victim reported that she started her car to warm it up then briefly returned inside her residence. When she came back outside a few minutes later, her **2010 red Dodge Avenger (PA Plate JJC-3654)** had been stolen. (56646)

**3/28/16 Robbery – Aldi Foods – 5200 Penn Avenue, 4:02pm.** Officers responded to Aldi's for a violent shoplifter who was armed with a knife. Store security told officers that they recognized the suspect from prior incidents and witnessed him concealing items today as well. They

approached him as he was leaving and asked to see his receipt, at which point he pulled out a knife and fled. The suspect was identified as **Bryan Eleam, 46, of Garfield**. A Zone 4 car which was in the area spotted Eleam in the 5100 block of Rosetta Street and took him into custody. Eleam was charged with Robbery since a weapon was used in the theft. **3/29/16 Burglary – 100 block N. Aiken Avenue, Occurred between 4:00pm and 8:00pm.** Victim reported that he returned home to find a rear window broken. A Glock Model 27 pistol and cash were missing from the residence. (56370)

**3/29/16 Stolen Vehicle – P&W BMW – 4801 Baum Blvd, 8:30pm.** Victim reported the dealership was just finishing the sales paperwork on a new BMW when they noticed the vehicle missing. Upon reviewing their security cameras, they saw a black male suspect in dark clothing walk into their garage and drive off with the car. Staff from P&W began checking the area and soon found the car parked on Gross Street. Detectives will attempt to identify the thief from the security camera footage. (56379)

#### **Stanton Heights/Morningside/Highland Park/East Liberty**

**3/27/16 Aggravated Assault (Domestic) – Natoli Field (Morningside), 9:30pm.** A 35 year-old female victim reported her ex-boyfriend, **John Graham, 44, of Stanton Heights**, attacked her and punched her in the face. Responding officers noted injuries on the victim's face and hands. Officers will obtain an arrest warrant for Graham. (55044)

**3/29/16 Theft from Vehicle – 300 block Princeton Place.** Victim reported someone stole her temporary license plate off of her vehicle. (56990)

**4/2/16 Theft from Vehicle – 1600 block Windcrest Drive, 12:00pm.** Victim reported that he looked out his window and saw (3) teenage black males rifling through his vehicle. The victim banged on his window and the kids fled. The victim reported his wallet containing cash, credit cards, and his driver's license were stolen. (59015)



### Notable Arrests

**3/29/16 at 1:59am – N. Braddock Ave & Mulford Street (Homewood):** Zone 5 officers were patrolling the area when they heard a call for a domestic where the male half had broken into his ex-girlfriend's house, then fled the scene. Officers Flickers and Maddox encountered a male matching the description of the suspect and stopped him to investigate. The male was identified as **Derrick Cabell, 48, of North Side**. Cabell was in possession of (2) bags of cocaine and (1) large bag of marijuana. Cabell was placed under arrest. The female victim in this domestic was not injured. (55813)

**3/31/16 at 10:53pm – 2200 block Wilner Drive (East Hills):** Pittsburgh Police Narcotics detectives were patrolling East Hills when they came upon a group of males standing around a tan Mercedes Benz. The detectives observed the men drinking alcohol and, as they approached, they could smell an odor of burnt marijuana coming from the car. The detectives noted two of the males in the back seat appeared very nervous and were trying to kick something under the front seats. Detectives removed the occupants from the vehicle to investigate further, at which point they found a stolen .40 caliber Ruger pistol under one seat and a stolen Inter-Arms .38 caliber revolver under the other seat. Detectives also recovered several bags of marijuana, (3) "bundles" of heroin stamped "48" in red ink, a digital scale, and just under \$1000.00 cash. Arrested were **Malik Mollett, 18, of Wilkinsburg, Marcus Watts, 18, of Crafton Heights, and a Male Juvenile, 17, of East Hills**. Mollett was charged with Firearms Not to Be Carried without a License, Receiving Stolen Property, Possession of Heroin, Possession with Intent to Deliver Heroin, and Possession of a Small Amount of Marijuana. The 17 year-old male was charged with Firearms Not to Be Carried without a License, Possession of a Firearm by a Minor, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Possession of a Small Amount of Marijuana. Watts was charged with Possession of a Small Amount of Marijuana. (57885)

**4/1/16 at 4:48pm – Broad Street & Sheridan Avenue (East Liberty):** Zone 5 officers were parked in the 7700 block of Frankstown Avenue when a vehicle passed them, emitting a very strong odor of burning marijuana. Officers followed this vehicle and were eventually able to conduct a traffic stop on Broad Street & Sheridan Avenue. The driver was identified as **Terrell Demond Bradford, 20, of the Hill District**. The passenger was identified as **Christopher Wilson**

**II, 24, of the Hill District.** Officers had the occupants step out of the vehicle and conducted a search of the car. The following items were located during the search: (3) large bags of marijuana, (2) smaller bags of marijuana, (2) digital scales, (7) bags of cocaine, drug packaging materials, and \$1,241.00 cash. Both Bradford and Wilson were placed under arrest. (58482)

**4/2/16 at 1:20am – 7200 block Kelly Street (Homewood):** Zone 5 officers conducted a traffic stop and detected a strong odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle while they were speaking with the driver. The driver was identified as **Malek Quintez Kelly, 19, of East Liberty.** Kelly was asked to step from the vehicle and complied. Officers then searched the vehicle and found a bag of marijuana and (2) firearms in the car - a Sig Sauer .40 caliber (loaded) and a Smith & Wesson 9mm (loaded). The Sig Sauer pistol was reported stolen. Additionally, Kelly did not possess a license to carry firearms, nor did he possess a license to operate a motor vehicle. Kelly was placed under arrest. **4/2/16 at 12:26pm – Auburn Street & Ashley Street (Larimer):** Zone 5 officers were on patrol when they smelled a strong odor of marijuana coming from a vehicle in front of them. The officers continued to follow this vehicle for a distance, to ensure they had the correct car. Eventually, the officers conducted a traffic stop on this vehicle. As the officers approached the car, the driver pulled off and fled at a high rate of speed. Fearing the safety of the public, the officers opted not to pursue the vehicle, but were able to get a good description of the driver. A few moments later, while searching the area, the officers saw the driver of the vehicle running up Vanilla Way towards Shetland Street. The male was pulling handfuls of marijuana from a large plastic bag and scattering it as he ran down the street. Officers were able to catch-up to the male and detain him. The suspect was identified as **Tyrone Claytor, 32, of Penn Hills.** Officers searched Claytor and his possessions, and found marijuana, cocaine, and \$3,350.00 cash. Claytor was arrested. (59025)
