Homewood / East Hills

12/29/15 Aggravated Assault on Unborn Child – Collier Street & Idlewild Street, 10:15am. A 31 year-old female victim reported that her boyfriend, **Edward Stewart, 37**, of Homewood, assaulted her while they were walking down the street. The victim indicated that Stewart punched her in the face, bit her, then punched her several times in her stomach. Victim also indicated that she is six months pregnant. Offices will obtain an arrest warrant for Edward Stewart. *He will be charged with Aggravated Assault on an Unborn Child and Simple Assault.* (247436)

Bloomfield/Garfield/Friendship

12/30/15 Theft from Vehicle – 5100 block Kincaid Street. A GoPro camera was stolen. No signs of forced entry. (248318)

1/1/16 Aggravated Assault (Stabbing) – Edmond Street & Corday Way, 1:26am. A 28 year-old male victim reports he was walking with his girlfriend when they observed a violent domestic between another man and his girlfriend. The victim intervened and tried to restrain the violent male to prevent him from injuring his girlfriend when that male pulled a knife and stabbed the victim in the shoulder. The victim transported himself to West Penn Hospital with non-life threatening injuries. Zone 5 officers encountered a male fitting the description of the suspect but the victim was not available to make an identification at that time. Zone 5 Plainclothes detectives will follow-up with the victim. (85)

Notable Arrests

12/30/15 at 4:30pm – 700 block Edmond Street (Bloomfield): PBP Narcotics detectives were investigating a tip that **Gregory Galvez, 41, of Bloomfield,** was selling drugs from his home in the 600 block of Edmond Street. Detectives witnessed Galvez make a heroin deal and were able to place him under arrest without incident. At the time detectives stopped him, Galvez was in possession of additional stamp bags of heroin. Detectives then went back to Galvez's residence, where they recovered (3) "bricks" of heroin (approx. 150 stamp bags) as well as marijuana. Galvez was transported to the Allegheny County Jail and was *charged with felony drug offenses.* (248195)
