WHAT IS THE YCAT STUDY?

The YCAT Study stands for Youth Computerized Adaptive Test. The YCAT is a computer test that will measure the experience and impact of having mood problems.

Both healthy kids, between 7-17 years old, and those in mental health treatment will be included in this test.

The test will ask questions about depression, anxiety, bipolar disorder, ADHD, oppositional defiant disorder (ODD) & conduct disorder (CD).

Participants taking the test will answer approximately 250 questions about their mood and behaviors on an IPAD.

The test will take about 2 hours to complete by both a parent/legal guardian & their child or teen. **No computer experience is necessary.**



WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR THE STUDY?

- Boys and Girls
 - Between 7-17 years old
 - Parent or legal guardian willing to participate
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- Currently in treatment for a mood or behavioral problem including: Bipolar disorder, Conduct disorder (CD), Oppositional Defiant Disorder (ODD), ADHD, depression and anxiety.
