



**Community Crime Update**  
**Zone 5 Police Station**  
**Week of Nov 16th – Nov 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2015**



**Homewood / East Hills**

**11/16/15 Aggravated Assault – 600 block Seagirt Street, 9:00pm.** Officers responded to the victim's neighbor's house to find a 27 year-old female victim with bruising to her face. The victim reports that she awoke to her boyfriend choking her and punching her in the face. She was able to escape and ran to a neighbor's house to call 911. Officers went to the victim's house and saw the suspect on the front porch. Upon seeing police, **Corey Sekou Edwards, 36, of East Hills**, retreated into the house and refused to come out. After several minutes, Edwards emerged and was taken into custody. *He was charged with Aggravated Assault and Resisting Arrest.* (220555)

**11/16/15 Burglary – 7400 block Monticello Street, Occurred between 8:00pm and 10:00pm.** Victim reports that she returned from a shopping trip to find her door damaged and clothing, electronics, shoes, and money orders all missing from the house. The victim suspects her roommate of damaging the door and stealing her property since the two had a falling out and the roommate was preparing to vacate the property. Investigation is ongoing. (220571)

**11/16/15 Burglary – 7200 block Finance Street, Occurred between 8:00am and 3:30pm.** Victim reports that she returned home to find her rear sliding door had been removed and she was unknown if anyone was inside. Officers cleared the residence and found the suspect(s) had already fled. Officers observed the house appeared to have been ransacked, but the victim did not believe anything had been stolen. **11/20/15 Burglary – 7000 block Monticello Street, Occurred between 11/5 and 11/20.** Victim reports that she arrived home from vacation to find her rear door kicked-in and copper pipes missing from her basement and an upstairs bedroom. Several other items were taken as well. (223128)

**11/19/15 Robbery / Aggravated Assault – Chaucer Street & N. Lang Avenue, 11:15pm.** A 45 year-old male victim reports that approximately one hour earlier he was robbed at gunpoint on the steps at the corner of Chaucer & Lang. The victim stated he was leaving the bar and was about halfway up the steps when (2) unknown suspects jumped out of the weeds. **Suspect # 1 was described as a black male, dark complexion, 14-18 years old, 6'0", thin build, wearing all back. Suspect # 2 was**

described as black male, dark complexion, 14-18 years old, 5'5", medium build, dressed in all black and wearing a black baseball cap. The suspects ordered him to the ground at which point one of the suspects "pistol-whipped" the victim. The suspects fled after the victim insisted that he had nothing of value on his person. **11/19/15 Aggravated Assault (Domestic) – 2100 block Park Hill Drive, 7:55pm.** A 20 year-old female victim reported that her husband, **Leonard Maurice Brown, Jr, 26**, strangled her until she passed out, then began punching her once she woke up. Brown fled prior to police arriving at the scene. Officers will obtain a warrant for his arrest. *Brown will be charged with Aggravated Assault.* (222545)

**11/21/15 Theft from Vehicle – 500 block Singer Place.** Victim reports she returned to her vehicle to find her gun and checkbook had been stolen. Victim indicates her car was unlocked. (223637)

**11/21/15 Robbery – 100 block White Pine Place, 8:45pm.** A 41 year-old male victim reports that he had just parked his car and was walking to his house when a black male, mid to late 20's, 6'0", wearing a gray hooded sweatshirt, approached him and pointed a gun at him. The suspect demanded the victim's wallet. The victim took off running, at which point the suspect fled down a path leading towards East Hills Drive. (224100)

**11/22/15 Attempted Homicide – 600 block N. Murtland Street, 11:45am.** Officers responded to a ShotSpotter notification and found a 34 year-old male victim who reported that his brother, **Brandon Lamont Randall, 20, of Homewood**, fired multiple shots at him. The victim was not struck. Randall fled but officers are in the process of obtaining an arrest warrant. *Randall will be charged with Criminal Attempt Homicide.* (224506)

### Larimer / Lincoln-Lemington

**11/18/15 Aggravated Assault (Domestic) – 7200 block Everton Street, 6:20pm.** A 23 year-old male victim reported that his girlfriend stabbed him in the arm with a knife after an argument. The victim was taken to the hospital in good condition. **Andreia Sharay Jones, 31, of Lincoln-Lemington**, was still on scene and was arrested. *She was charged with Aggravated Assault.* (221811)

**11/19/15 Burglary – 1600 block Broadhead Street, Occurred between 11/18 at 2:00pm and 11/19 at 1:00am.** Victim reports that someone broke into his garage and stole a Husky 8 gallon air compressor. (222258)

**11/20/15 Shots Fired – 900 block Laxton Street, 3:38am.** Officers patrolling the Larimer area heard gunfire and moments later the ShotSpotter system alerted that (13) rounds had been fired at Lyric & Laxton Streets. Officers arrived to find a gray Chevy Tahoe with several bullet holes. Additionally one house was struck by gunfire. The occupants of the house were safe and advised that nobody had been injured. This incident is still under investigation. (222783)

### **Bloomfield/Garfield/Friendship**

**11/18/15 Robbery (Pickpocket) – Cricket Lounge - 280 Morewood Avenue, 1:00am.** A 22 year-old male victim reported that he and a friend were drinking inside of the club when someone stole his wallet from his pocket. The victim found his wallet a short time later but his money was gone. (221344)

### **Stanton Heights/Morningside/Highland Park/East Liberty**

**11/16/15 Robbery – 1100 block DeVictor Place, 8:30pm.** A 25 year-old male victim reports that he had just arrived home and was walking up to his house when he noticed a newer model white Toyota sedan pull onto his street and flash its headlights at him. The victim reports that moments later the driver and a passenger exited the car and attempted to pull him into the vehicle. The victim tried to resist but a third male came up behind him and he could hear the sound of a gun racking. According to the victim, one of the suspects demanded his money and he handed over his wallet, at which point the suspects fled. The suspects are described as (3) black males between 15-17 years old The driver was dark complected, clean shaven, with a "high top" haircut. The other two suspects were also dark complexion, wearing dark hooded sweatshirts. (220538)

**11/16/15 Theft from Vehicle – Fairfield Court.** Victim reports he found the contents of the center console were strewn about his car when he left for work this morning. \$6.00 and some work keys had been stolen. There were no signs of forced entry into his vehicle. (220060)

**11/16/15 Theft from Vehicle – Stanton Court East.** Victim reports someone rifled through her glove box and stole \$7.00 cash. Victim may have left her vehicle unlocked.

**11/17/15 Burglary – 5700 block Bryant Street, Occurred between 2:00pm and 11:45pm.** Victim reports that someone forced their way into his 2<sup>nd</sup> floor office door and stole money from a filing cabinet. (221311)

**11/17/15 Robbery – 500 block N. Highland Avenue, 10:08pm.** Officers responded to a report of a fight between one male and two females in the street. Upon arrival, a 54 year-old male victim reported that he was assaulted by two known females, one of whom then took his car keys. The victim was intoxicated and uncooperative. He refused medical treatment and would not give officers the suspect's information. (221269)

**11/18/15 Theft from Vehicle – Stanton Avenue & N. Euclid Avenue.** Victim reports that someone entered his unlocked vehicle and stole headphones and a knife. (221481)

**11/19/15 Robbery (Domestic) – Capri Pizza – 6001 Penn Avenue, 1:40pm.** A 24 year-old female victim reports that her ex-boyfriend, **Richard L. Cameron, 28, (Unknown address)**, came into the pizza shop and snatched her cell phone out of her hand, then fled. Officers will obtain an arrest warrant for Cameron. *He will be charged with Robbery.* (222304)

**11/19/15 Robbery/Aggravated Assault (Domestic) – Cambria Court, 11:05pm.** A 23 year-old female victim reports that she was having an argument with her ex-boyfriend, **Xavier Thompson Clay, 20, of East Liberty**, when he became violent. The victim stated Clay grabbed her by the shirt collar and began throwing her around the apartment, then retrieved a knife and threatened to kill her. Clay then stole the victim's cell phone and fled. Officers will obtain an arrest warrant for Clay. *He will be charged with Robbery, Aggravated Assault, and Recklessly Endangering Another Person.* (222650)



### **Notable Arrests**

**11/19/15 at 1:45am – 7500 block Tioga Street (Homewood):** Officers responded to an activation of the ShotSpotter gunshot detection system in the 7500 block of Tioga Street in Homewood. ShotSpotter alerted responding units that (3) shots had been fired. One of the officers was in the area at the time and witnessed a car quickly leaving the area where the shots had been fired. Officers conducted a traffic stop on this vehicle to determine if it was involved in the shooting. During the traffic

stop, the officers could see a baggy of cocaine in the car while they were conversing with the occupants. The occupants were asked to step from the vehicle and they complied. The driver and passenger were placed into custody and the vehicle was searched. Officers recovered the baggy of cocaine, but also found a jar of marijuana and a .40 caliber Glock pistol. It should be noted that the magazine to the gun was loaded with all but (3) rounds. It should also be noted that the shell casings found at the scene were .40 caliber. Officers interviewed the driver, **Raymond Denson, 36, of Forest Hills,** and learned that he does not possess a license to carry firearms. Officers also learned that he was the person who fired the shots on Tioga Street. *Denson was charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance, Possession of a Small Amount of Marijuana, Discharging a Firearm in the City, Firearms Not to be Carried without a License, and Persons Not to Possess Firearms.* The passenger was subsequently released from custody and will not be charged. (222013)

**11/21/15 at 3:00am – Frankstown Avenue & Torrens Street (Larimer):**

Officers conducted a traffic stop on a black Hyundai Sonata after witnessing a vehicle code violation. Upon approaching the vehicle, the driver appeared extremely nervous and kept adjusting his waistband. Fearing for their safety, officers conducted a pat-down of the driver and found a Glock Model 23, .40 caliber pistol in his waistband. The driver, **Montelle Lawon Lewis, 25, of Knoxville,** did not have a license to carry a firearm. Additionally, his driver's license was found to be suspended. *Lewis was arrested and charged with Firearms Not to be Carried without a License, Driving Under Suspension, and vehicle code violations.* (223525)
