Homewood / East Hills

12/14/15 Burglary - 7700 Monticello Street, Occurred between 6:00AM and 10:10 AM. Victim told Zone 5 Officers when he got home he heard someone running down the basement steps. Victim then ran out of his house towards the side trying to catch the burglars. Victim chased 2 black males who ran from his home but was unable to catch them. Victim told Officers he saw one of them enter 1249 Mohler Street. Officers knocked at this address and made contact with a juvenile and his mother. The juvenile made a spontaneous utterance telling Officers, "I was there and a man named Donte AKA Streets committed the burglary". The victim refused to cooperate and would not identify the juvenile as being the one he chased. Victim repeatedly told Officers he wanted to prosecute the adult. Taken in the burglary was a 5 disc CD player and brown Nike Air Max shoes. Entry was made through an unlocked side door. (238487)

12/14/15 Burglary - 1200 block North Murtland Street, Occurred between 10:00PM on 12/13 and 10:00 AM on 12/14. Victim told Zone 5 Officers when he returned home someone had burglarized his home taking the copper pipes from the basement. Entry was made through the rear basement doors. (238623)

12/17/15 Attempted Theft from Vehicle – Rosedale Street & Hill Avenue. Victim returned to her vehicle to find front passenger window broken and her car had been ransacked. Nothing missing. (240873)

12/18/15 Burglary - 2200 block Wilner Drive, Occurred between 1:00pm and 3:00pm. Victim reports her home was burglarized sometime after she left at 1:00pm and her son returned home from school at 3:00pm. Victim stated her son arrived home to find the rear door forced open and numerous items missing from the residence, to include: (3) 50" flat screen TV's, an X-Box gaming system and multiple games, headphones, and clothing items. 12/18/15 Burglary – 500 block Cora Street, Occurred between 7:30am and 8:30pm. Victim reports she returned home to find her house ransacked. Officers noticed the back door had been forced open. Cash, jewelry, and clothing were stolen. (241517)

12/18/15 Burglary – 7000 block Monticello Street, 9:30pm. Officers responded to a theft-in-progress. Upon their arrival, the victim informed them that a guy she only knows as “Dave” broke into her apartment and stole her television. The victim returned home as this was occurring and confronted “Dave,” who left the home with her television. The victim directed officers to a location in the 7000 block of Forest Way where “Dave” is known to hang out. Officers searched the location and found the victim’s TV... but not Dave. This victim’s TV was returned to her. Detectives are working to learn “Dave’s” real identity. (241546)

12/19/15 Aggravated Assault (Domestic) – 1300 block Heart Court, 5:12pm. Officers responded to a report of a violent domestic and arrived to find a 21 year-old male victim cut or stabbed in the face and arms. The victim’s girlfriend, **Ka-Lona Mitchell, 22, of Homewood**, was placed under arrest. *She was charged with Aggravated Assault.* (242067)

Larimer / Lincoln-Lemington

12/17/15 Theft from Vehicle – 6500 block Deary Street. Victim reports he was making deliveries of rental furniture. His Hertz truck was unattended and the back door was open. A witness saw a **black male, 5’10,” 180 Lbs, with dreadlocks, wearing a black jacket and camoflaue pants**, remove a 50” TV from the truck and walk down the street with it. (240560)

12/18/15 Burglary – 6400 block Olivant Street, Occurred between 6:40am and 6:40pm. Victim reports that her home was burglarized while she was out. Victim suspected her ex—boyfriend, **Tyree Williams, 25, of the Hill District**, of committing the crime. According to the victim, she contacted Williams and an argument ensued, at which point he admitted to entering the house and stealing the items. Officers will obtain an arrest warrant for Williams. He will be charged with Burglary. (241439)

12/18/15 Burglary – East Chester Street, Occurred between 12/17 at 6:00pm and 12/18 at 6:00pm. Victim reports someone broke into her residence and stole her 60” LG TV, a 40” TV, and an iPad. There were no signs of forced entry, however, the victim did notice a window slightly open. (241417)

Bloomfield/Garfield/Friendship

12/14/15 Theft from Vehicle - 4900 block Cypress Street, Occurred between 4:30 PM on 12/14 and 6:45 AM on 12/15. Victim told Zone 5 Officers when he went to his truck in the morning he noticed the center console was open. Taken from the truck was a Glock 19 (9) mm handgun and some change. (239102)

12/15/15 Burglary – 500 block S. Mathilda Street, Occurred between 12/15 at 11:00pm and 12/16 at 5:45am. Victim reports he woke up to find his car missing. Victim stated the rear window to his residence had been left unlocked and he noticed some bottles had been knocked off the window sill and were laying on the ground. A wallet and keys were also taken. **The stolen vehicle is a 2009 green Toyota Corolla (PA plate JRX-6721).** (239789)

12/14/15 Aggravated Assault-600 North St. Clair Street, Occurred between 2:20 AM and 2:30 AM. Victim told Zone 5 Officers she got into an argument with her intimate partner and he began to choke her. The actor **Mark Easley** then picked up a knife and showed it to victim. Victim and **Easley** began to fight over the knife before Easley cut victim twice on the left forearm. Easley fled residence. Officers were called back a short time later when **Easley** returned and placed (**Mark Easley, 46 of East Liberty**) under arrest for Aggravated Assault. (238330)

12/16/15 Theft from Vehicle – 1300 block N. Sheridan Avenue. Victim reports someone stole a new microwave from the back seat of her vehicle. No signs of forced entry. (239907)

12/16/15 Robbery/Aggravated Assault – 5600 block Wellesley Street, 11:45pm. Officers responded to a report of shots fired in the 5600 block of Wellesley Street in Highland Park. Officers arrived on scene to find a 28 year-old male victim on the ground with an apparent gunshot wound to the left side. The victim indicated that he was approached by **two suspects, one white male and one white female, both wearing gray hooded sweatshirts,** who dragged him into the street and tried to steal his bag. During the scuffle, the victim stated that one of the suspects shot him. The victim was transported to the hospital by EMS, where it was learned he also sustained a gunshot wound to his lower back. After the shooting, the suspects fled on foot towards Jackson. Major Crimes is handling this case. (240287)

12/18/15 Burglary – 5700 block Baum Blvd, Occurred between 12:00pm and 11:00pm. Victim reports he returned to his apartment to find his iPad Air and his MacBook were missing. There were no signs of forced entry and there are bars over the window. The victim does have a roommate but does not suspect him of stealing his belongings. (241641)

12/18/15 Burglary (Domestic) – 800 block N. Sheridan Avenue, 12:30am. Officers responded to a domestic and arrived to find that the suspect, **Kahlil Morris, 38, of East Hills**, had fled. The victim stated that Morris is her ex-boyfriend and forced his way into the residence tonight, assaulting her and breaking items in her bedroom. Officers did observe minor injuries to the victim. Officers will obtain an arrest warrant for Morris. He will be charged with Burglary. (240959)



Notable Arrests

12/15/15 at 6:30pm – 6500 block Deary Street (Lincoln-Lemington): In response to several complaints from the community, Pittsburgh Police Narcotics detectives began an investigation into a residence in the 6500 block of Deary Street. The investigation resulted in a search warrant, which was served on 12/15 with the assistance of PGH SWAT. During a search of the residence, officers recovered a loaded Taurus .357 revolver, a loaded Mossberg .22 caliber rifle, crack cocaine, a digital scale, drug packaging materials, and ammunition. The resident, **Lamont Willis, 24**, was not home at the time. Detectives will obtain a warrant for his arrest. (239501)
